



**9th FIPS-Mouche World Youth Fly Fishing Championships
and Conservation Symposium
Liptovsky Mikulas, Slovakia, 3-9 August 2010**

RULE MODIFICATIONS

FIPS-Mouche has appointed SLOVAKIA to be the host country for the 9th FIPS-Mouche World Youth Fly Fishing Championship and Conservation Symposium to be held in Liptovsky Mikulas area, Slovakia. These Rule Modifications apply to the 2009 FIPS-Mouche Competition Rules.

ARTICLE 2: GENERAL INFORMATION

2.2. Add: Five sessions will be held in rivers, bank fishing, wading allowed.
Annex A Rotation Matrix.

ARTICLE 9: BANK FISHING COMPETITIONS

9.3. Add: The beats on the river will be an average of 200 m with a buffer zone of 10-20 m on each side.

Add New 9.6: Wading in river is allowed in all sessions and chest waders may be worn.

ARTICLE 11: DURATION OF THE EVENTS, AND SCORING AND PRACTICE SESSIONS

11.3. Add: The hours for fishing will be 09:00-12:00 and 15:00-18:00.

11.4. Add: All official practice will be catch and release.

ARTICLE 22: CARE OF FISH CAUGHT

22.1; Add: To score a fish, a competitor may not touch the fish before measuring.

Add 22.4. In the exceptional case of a dispute regarding eligibility, a fish may be killed, if it is necessary for evidence.

ARTICLE 24: ELIGIBLE FISH

Add new 24.4. The fish will be measured from the tip of the nose to the extremities of the tail, squeezed together. The eligible fish will be:

Rivers:

Fish species: Brown trout (*Salmo trutta morfa fario*)
Lake trout (*Salmo trutta morfa lacustris*)
Rainbow trout (*Oncorhynchus mykiss*),
Brook trout (*Salvelinus fontinalis*)
Danube Salmon (*Hucho hucho*)
Grayling (*Thymalus thymalus*)

Each of the species will be illustrated

Size limits: 180 mm

ARTICLE 29: LANDING NETS

29.3. Add new: Competitors must supply their own landing nets .
