



## **Rule Modifications**

### **29-th FIPS-Mouche World Fly Fishing Championships Scotland 5<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> June 2009**

FIPS-Mouche has appointed Scotland to be the host country for the 29<sup>th</sup> FIPS-Mouche World Fly Fishing Championship and Conservation Symposium to be held in Drymen, Scotland. These Rule Modifications apply to the 2007 FIPS-Mouche Competition Rules.

#### **Article 2 : General Information**

**2.2 Add :** Four sessions will be held on loch sectors, fishing from boats powered by outboard motors and one session on river fishing from bank or wading. The Rotation of Groups is contained in **Annexe A**.

#### **Article 9 : Bank Fishing Competitions**

**Add new 9.6 :** Wading is allowed on the river sector and chest waders may be worn.

#### **Article 10 : Boat Fishing Competitions**

The lochs shall only be fished on Official Competition Days.

There will be two competitors per boat. Competitors may only fish while the boat is drifting freely and not under power or being rowed.

Boats may drift with the bow either to the left or to the right.

Drogues shall not be used.

Competitors may only cast in the area allocated in **Annexe B**.

**Add new 10.11 :** Competitors are required to wear a life jacket whenever they are in a boat, on a landing stage or fishing the river.

#### **Article 11 : Duration of events, scoring and practice sessions**

**Add new 11.5:** All practice sessions will be catch and release.

#### **Article 24 : Eligible Fish**

**24.1 Add :** The eligible fish are :- Brown Trout, Grayling and Rainbow Trout. The minimum length of all eligible species caught during the Championship at all sectors is twenty ( 20 ) centimetres measured from the tip of the nose to the end of the tail.

#### **Article 28: Competition Flies**

**28.2 Add new :** Fly size at the Lake of Menteith not to exceed one and a quarter ins.( 1¼ ).*(This is a local rule which applies only at the Lake of Menteith)*

#### **Article 29 : Landing Nets**

**Add new 29.3 :** Only the nets supplied with the boats in the loch competitions may be used to net fish. *(Safety factor and local rule at Lake of Menteith)*
