

40th FIPS-Mouche World Fly Fishing Championship Finland 2021

RULE MODIFICATIONS

<u>FIPS-Mouche</u> has appointed Finland to be the host country for the 40th FIPS-Mouche World Fly Fishing Championship to be held in Kuusamo and Taivalkoski Regions, Finland. These Rule Modifications apply to the <u>latest published FIPS-Mouche Competition Rules</u>.

Article 2: General Information

2.2. Add Three sessions will be held in rivers, bank fishing, wading allowed. **Two** sessions will be held in lake, boat fishing.

Article 9: Bank Fishing Competitions

- **9.3. Change:** The beats on sectors I and V will be an average of 150m and for sector III an average of 150m, all with buffer zones of 5 metres.
- **9.7 Add:** Wading is allowed on the sectors I, III and V and chest waders may be worn.
- **9.8 Add:** Shuffling of the riverbed or excessive movement while wading is not allowed. Fishing downstream just below the competitor within a rod length of the competitor is forbidden.

Article 10: Boat fishing competitions

10.1 Change: There will be 2 competitors fishing in each boat.

10.4 Change: Boats will be launched 15 minutes before the start of the session.

10.6 Change: Organizers provide portable and padded boat seats and so no other additional

cushion is allowed.

10.9 add: Fishing on sectors II and IV will be from drifting boats, drogues may be used during

drifting (see annex B).

Eye protection (glasses) will be used, life vest will be used. Competitor shall bring their own

life vest. The drogues are provided by the organiser.

Article 11: Duration of events, scoring and practice sessions

11.3. Add: The hours for fishing will be in the program of the championship: from 09:00 to

12:00 and from 16:00 to 19:00.

No official practice will be arranged. Unofficial practice will be fished with barbless hooks.

Article 30: Article 30: Landing net

30.3. Add: Minimal length of the net is 100 cm (defined in Covid protocol for 2021)

Article 25: Eligible fish

25.1. Add: Eligible fish species:

Brown Trout (Salmo Trutta), Rainbow Trout (Oncorhynchus mykiss), Grayling (Thymallus

Thymallus), Whitefish (Coregonus Lavaretus) with a minimum length as following:

Brown Trout, Rainbow, Whitefish: 200mm

Grayling: 250 mm

Measuring will be done from the tip of the nose to the extremities of the tail, squeezed

together.

Article 29: Competition flies

29.5. Change: There are maximum two flies allowed on the rivers and maximum three flies

allowed on the lakes.

Article 33: Awarding of points

Add: Eligible fish will score 100 points a fish and 20 points a cm of its length.
