MOTION: & REGLEMENT

- 1. Background. During World Championships the anglers are catching various fish species and the anglers are proud of their catches. The individual catches of the anglers are recorded on the catch card and electronic weigh-in program. All the fish being caught, which qualifies to be recorded as the catch of the angler based on the specific angling rules, are recorded during a World Championship.
- 2. We refer to the FIPSed governing documents:

Statues Article

ARTICLE 9 FIPS-Mouche PRESIDENTIAL BOARD

- 9.1 The FIPS-Mouche Presidential Board shall be elected by the General Assembly for a period of 4 (four) years. It shall be composed of:
 - a) The President, who is responsible for the general management of FIPS-Mouche. He shall be a member of the C.I.P.S. Presidential Board and shall represent FIPS-Mouche externally to third parties;
 - b) The First Vice-President who becomes interim President until the next Congress, if the President is unable to perform his Presidential functions; he will be responsible for recommending statute changes to the Presidential Board;
 - c) The Second Vice-President is the Chairman of the Technical Commission and is responsible for recommending changes in the Competition Rules to the Presidential Board, and for maintaining any international calendar of events;
 - d) The General Secretary, who, in agreement with the President, is responsible for the observance of the Statutes, correspondence, invitations, financial affairs, and reports of all FIPS-Mouche meetings;
 - e) The Technical Commission consisting of the second Vice-President as chairman, the Senior International Supervisor and members proposed by the Presidential Board and confirmed by the FIPS-Mouche General Assembly

FIPS-Mouche Competition Rules

- 3. Proposal. The alteration of the articles above to read as follows:
 - a. Statues Article

ARTICLE 9

FIPS-Mouche PRESIDENTIAL BOARD

9.1 The FIPS-Mouche Presidential Board shall be elected by the General Assembly for a period of 4 (four) years. It shall be composed of:

- a) The President, who is responsible for the general management of FIPS-Mouche. He shall be a member of the C.I.P.S. Presidential Board and shall represent FIPS-Mouche externally to third parties;
- b) The First Vice-President who becomes interim President until the next Congress, if the President is unable to perform his Presidential functions; he will be responsible for recommending statute changes to the Presidential Board;
- c) The Second Vice-President is the Chairman of the Technical Commission and is responsible for recommending changes in the Competition Rules to the Presidential Board, and for maintaining any international calendar of events;
- d) The General Secretary, who, in agreement with the President, is responsible for the observance of the Statutes, correspondence, invitations, financial affairs, and reports of all FIPS-Mouche meetings;
- e) The Technical Commission consisting of the second Vice-President as chairman, the Senior International Supervisor and members proposed by the Presidential Board and confirmed by the FIPS-Mouche General Assembly.
- f) The "Records Official" to deal with the administration of world fishing records as applied by anglers through their National Federation and issuing of certificates to qualified catches.

- 1. An angler participating in a World Fishing Championship may apply for a FIPS-Mouche World Record of a specific fish caught which qualifies to be recorded as a record.
- 2. The records register will be administrated by the FIPS-Mouche Records official and will present qualifying records to the FIPS-Mouche Presidential Board.
- 3. Once an application is approved by the FIPS-Mouche Presidential Board, a certificate will be issued for the angler to the angler's National Federation at the FIPS-Mouche General Assembly.
- 4. The application for a FIPS-Mouche World Record must be submitted on the FIPS-Mouche World Record Application Form and submitted to the FIPS-Mouche Secretary by email.
