RULE MODIFICATIONS

[FIPS-Mouche](#) has appointed Italy to be the host country for the 19th CORTLAND Youth World Fly Fishing Championship to be held in ITALY, Trentino.

These Rule Modifications apply to the [latest published FIPS-Mouche Competition Rules](#).

Article 2 : General Information

2.2. Add: Four sessions will be held in rivers, bank fishing, wading allowed. One session will be held on lake, bank fishing, wading not allowed.

Article 9: Bank Fishing Competitions

9.3. Add: The beats on the river will be an average of 150 (one hundred and fifty) meters with buffer zones of 5 (five) meters. The beats on the lake will on average be 15 (fifteen) meters with buffer zones of 3 (three) meters

9.7 Add: Wading is allowed only on the river sectors and chest waders may be worn.

Article 29 : Competition Flies

Change in 29.6: a maximum of 3 flies is allowed on the lake sector. On the river sectors a maximum of 2 flies is allowed.

Article 11: Duration of events, scoring and practice sessions

11.3. Add: The hours for fishing will be in the program of the championship: from 09:00 to 12:00 (12.45 for the lake session) . During the lake session a rotation will take place every 45 minutes. Time between rotations is 15 minutes.

Add – All unofficial practice will be fished with barbless hooks.

Article 24: Eligible fish

Add: Eligible fish species: all trout species and grayling minium size of 200mm

Measuring will be done from the tip of the nose to the extremities of the tail, squeezed together.

Article 33: Awarding of Points

Add : each eligible fish will score 100 points and 20 points / cm
