COMPETITION DAYS

COMPETITION SECTORS:

Use google map with sectors and beats.

SECTOR I: Lake – no drogues allowed

SECTOR II: 2 large islands

Beats 6 & 7 share one 200 m long island. Controllers **MUST** be working from this island.

They reach the island min. 30 mins before session start.

Beats 9 &10: No fishing zone between the island and left bank.

SECTOR III: DRY FLY ONLY.

On Beat 3 & 4 Controllers must cross the river and work from the right bank.

Competitors fishing the beats 12-15 will not enter the bus, just walk along with controller to their competition beats

SECTOR IV: On Beat 15 Controller works from the right bank.

Competitors fishing the beat nr 1 will not enter the bus, just walk along with controller to his competition beat

SECTOR V: LIMITED TELEPHONE COVERAGE on BEATS 1-5, 2 BUSES & A PICKUP TRUCK WILL OPERATE.

CONTROLLERS

MOSTLY COMPETITION ANGLERS

MAJORITY WILL USE WADERS

WHEREVER NECESSARY: FOR SAFETY REASONS CONTROLLERS WILL BE ALLOWED TO STAY IN THE WATER, AS CLOSE AS POSSIBLE TO THE BANK TO AVOID THE HOGWEED
